Information about cookies and similar technologies used by WhaleScan.

1. Introduction

This Cookie Policy explains how WhaleScan, operated by Liberandum AI FZCO (“Company”, “we”, “us” or “our”), uses cookies and similar technologies when you visit or use <https://whalescan.net/> and related digital interfaces (the “Platform”).

This Cookie Policy should be read together with our Privacy Policy, which explains how we process Personal Data more generally.

2. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files or similar data records that may be stored on your browser or device when you visit a website. They can enable websites to remember information about your session, preferences, device or previous interactions.

We may also use similar technologies such as local storage, session storage, pixels, tags, SDKs or comparable browser and device technologies. In this Policy, references to “cookies” include these similar technologies where appropriate.

3. Why WhaleScan Uses Cookies

Depending on the configuration of the Platform and your choices, WhaleScan may use cookies for the following purposes:

- Essential functionality - to operate login sessions, maintain security, remember authentication state, prevent abuse and provide core website functionality.
- Preferences - to remember user interface preferences or settings where such functionality is enabled.
- Analytics and performance - to understand how users interact with the Platform, diagnose technical issues, measure traffic and improve performance and usability.
- Authentication - to support sign-in functionality, including sign-in through third-party authentication providers where available.
- Payments and subscriptions - to support checkout, subscription management, fraud prevention and payment-related functionality provided by payment service providers.
- Marketing or attribution - where implemented and permitted, to understand the effectiveness of campaigns or referral sources and to measure conversions.

4. Categories of Cookies

WhaleScan may use the following categories of cookies:

- Strictly Necessary Cookies. These are required for core Platform functions such as authentication, security, session management and fraud prevention. Disabling them may prevent parts of the Platform from functioning.
- Preference Cookies. These remember optional choices or settings to make the Platform more convenient to use.
- Analytics Cookies. These help us understand Platform usage, such as page visits, feature usage, technical performance and aggregated interaction patterns.

- Marketing or Attribution Cookies. If enabled, these may help measure campaign performance, referral sources or conversions. Where consent is required, such cookies should not be activated until the relevant consent has been obtained.
- Third-Party Cookies. Certain providers integrated into WhaleScan may set or read cookies for authentication, payments, analytics, security or other functions.

5. Legal Basis and Consent

Where Personal Data is processed through cookies, we process such information in accordance with applicable data protection requirements, including the UAE Federal Decree-Law No. 45 of 2021 Concerning the Protection of Personal Data, where applicable.

Where we rely on consent, consent will be requested in a clear and accessible manner and may be withdrawn. Where cookies are strictly necessary to provide a service requested by the User or to maintain security and essential functionality, they may operate without optional-cookie consent to the extent permitted by applicable law.

If WhaleScan is made available to Users in jurisdictions that impose additional cookie-consent requirements, we may adapt the cookie banner, consent options and cookie settings for those Users.

6. Cookie Consent and Preference Controls

Where a cookie consent banner or settings panel is made available, you may use it to accept, reject or manage non-essential cookie categories.

Your preferences may themselves be stored in a necessary cookie or similar browser storage so that the Platform can remember your choice.

You may withdraw or change your preferences later through any “Cookie Settings” control made available on the Platform. If no such control is available, you may also manage cookies through your browser settings.

7. Browser Controls

Most browsers allow you to view, delete or block cookies, and to configure how future cookies are handled. Browser controls differ between providers and devices.

Blocking all cookies may cause parts of WhaleScan to stop functioning correctly, including login, security, subscription management or saved preferences.

8. Third-Party Providers

WhaleScan may use third-party service providers for hosting, content delivery, security, authentication, payments, analytics, communications or other technical functions. These providers may process device, network or usage information and may set their own cookies or similar technologies.

The specific providers used by WhaleScan may change over time. Where practical, the Platform's cookie consent interface or an updated version of this Policy may identify the principal non-essential providers currently in use.

Third-party cookies and data processing are also subject to the privacy policies and terms of the relevant provider.

9. Information That Cookies May Collect

Depending on the cookie or technology, information collected may include:

- IP address or approximate network location;
- browser type, operating system and device information;
- session identifiers and authentication status;
- pages viewed, clicks, feature usage and interaction events;

- referral source, campaign or attribution parameters;
- error, performance and diagnostic data;
- cookie-consent and preference selections.

We do not intend cookies to be used to collect private keys, wallet seed phrases or credentials for third-party blockchain wallets.

10. Retention

Cookie retention periods vary depending on their purpose. Some cookies expire when you close your browser or end a session, while others may remain for a defined period so that preferences, authentication or analytics information can be retained.

We seek to retain Personal Data collected through cookies only for as long as reasonably necessary for the relevant purpose, subject to legal, security, fraud-prevention, contractual and record-keeping requirements.

11. International Data Transfers

Some technology providers may process information in countries outside the UAE. Where Personal Data is transferred internationally, we seek to use appropriate arrangements and safeguards as required by applicable data protection law.

12. Your Data Protection Rights

Depending on applicable law and the circumstances, you may have rights in relation to Personal Data processed through cookies, including rights to request information about processing, request correction or erasure, restrict certain processing, object to certain processing, withdraw consent where processing is based on consent, and request transfer of data where the legal requirements are met.

Requests relating to Personal Data may be submitted using the contact details below. Certain rights may be subject to legal limitations or exceptions.

13. Updates to this Cookie Policy

We may update this Cookie Policy from time to time to reflect changes to the Platform, technology, providers or applicable law. The “Last updated” date will be revised when changes are made.

Where a change materially affects how non-essential cookies or Personal Data are used, we may provide an additional notice or request renewed consent where required.
